"STRESS, ANXIETY AND RESILIENCE"



TOPIC: Schools throughout Florida are continuing to face unprecedented times. While COVID continues to impact school operations, students, teachers and administrators are dealing with the stress and anxiety related to the ongoing pandemic and issues related to expectations of being back at school and in the classroom. Her presentation will cover stress, anxiety, risk factors, sustained stress affects, and how to develop resilience.

ABOUT OUR PRESENTER *Dr. Gilda Moreno is a clinical psychologist and is the Clinical Group Counselor for the Doctoral and Master's programs at Miami Children's Hospital. She has special competencies in student clinical supervision, art therapy, and parent effectiveness training. With degrees in Design, Art Therapy and Psychology, Gilda has been interviewed numerous times on television on psychological issues related to children including: anxiety, bullying, tattling, divorce, shoplifting, hectic lives, mental health, etc. She has published a number of articles and is also a conference presenter. She has been on the board of the Child Prevention (CAP) Project of Miami.*

Tony has produced hundreds of instructional videos, and he shares examples, advice, ideas, techniques, and tools for creating your own masterpieces. You can apply this information to videos you might make for remote learning, blended learning, or differentiated instruction. Tony will use free video editing tools in his demonstrations, including Adobe Spark, Screencastify, and Flipgrid. It's best if you have a PC, Mac, or Chromebook so you can fully participate.

ABOUT OUR PRESENTER: *Tony Vincent has been a pioneer in digital learning since 1998, having a classroom website before many classrooms even had internet access. In 2001 he had a one-to-one classroom with Palm Pilots and in 2005 started one of the first podcasts from an elementary school. He taught fifth grade for six years and was the school's technology coach for a couple more. In 2006, he became an educational consultant and has traveled almost every state, and to Canada, Australia, England and the Caribbean to facilitate workshops and to make presentations to K12 students and teachers. Arvi Balseiro, Ph.D. presents "THE BODY'S POWER: INATTENTIVENESS TO ENGAGEMENT"



TOPIC: Understanding the importance of the development of students' sensory systems and applying techniques in the classroom or on the field increases their capacity to attend to tasks, improve motor performance, enhance postural stability and decrease impulsivity. All educators can acquire the toolkit to shift students' inattentiveness to engagement.

OUR PRESENTER: *Dr. Arvi Balseiro has been the Head of The Cushman School for the last 10 years. She is one of only three Heads of School to lead Miami-Dade's oldest, continuously operating private school. Dr. Balseiro completed her doctoral degree at Nova Southeastern University in Brain-Based Curriculum and Leadership. Her interest in understanding the relationship between the Sensory System and Attention led to her dissertation on The Effect of a Sensory System Intervention on the Attention Span of Grade 1 Students. Dr. Balseiro sits on the Florida Council of Independent Schools' Board of Trustees and served on the Florida Kindergarten Council and MIMO District's Board as well.*
